Last week I was able to go on retreat to a monastery at St. John's Abbey in Collegeville, MN. I'd never been to St. John's campus

before, but I couldn't believe how beautiful it was and how much it had to offer for its students. The abbey was on the edge of a beautiful lake surrounded by miles and miles of hiking trails. One afternoon, we had several hours to ourselves so I decided to hike to the chapel across the lake with my camera and enjoy the nice weather. While hiking I saw a great blue heron, a family of geese, a loon, a chipmunk, seven turtles, several songbirds, and three ticks.



I also came across this beautiful statue of St. Kateri, also known as Lily of the Mohawks.

She was the first indigenous saint recognized in the Catholic church and her story is pretty incredible. The chapel I hiked to was on the edge of the lake and was small and simple in the best way. I loved the stained glass windows inside and the beautiful statue of Mother Mary.





When I made my way back to the abbey, I walked to the other side of campus to the potter's studio. The studio is one of a kind. The artist-inresidence and master potter, Richard Bresnahan, studied pottery from the masters in

Japan, and now only takes two to three apprentices every year. The university's kiln is the largest of its kind in North America. Measuring 87 ft. in length, 7 ft. height, 6 ft. width, this three-chambered wood-burning kiln is only fired once every two years. The studio only produces pottery and sculpture using local materials and environmentally-responsible processes. I loved getting to meet the Richard and his apprentices and was even able to have tea with them!

This time away was beautiful and restful for me. It gave me the space I needed to contemplate and pray and I'm looking forward to my visits there in the future!
