Looking ahead to LENT

The 40-day season of Lent is a journey to Jesus' death and resurrection. In our hymnal's Invitation to Lent liturgy, it states: "We are created to experience joy in communion with God, to love one another, and to live in harmony with creation." We are called to journey in a way that "contends against evil and resists whatever leads us away from God and neighbor." As we prepare our hearts for the death and resurrection of Jesus, we also remember our own baptisms and gift of new life.

The Lenten worship schedule begins on March 5 with our Ash Wednesday service at 7:00 PM, with Imposition of Ashes and Holy Communion. We will continue with 7:00 PM Lenten evening prayer services (about half an hour long) for the next 5 Wednesdays to follow. The congregation is invited to supper in the fellowship hall at 6:15 prior to those services. We have adjusted our LOGOS schedule during Lent to make congregational suppers and an earlier worship time possible, in hopes of accommodating more of our St. Paul family.
