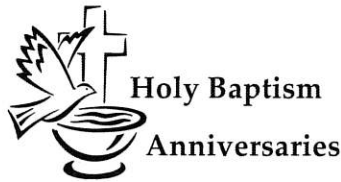

Community Basket - May 2026 Report

No matter where we are in life, we are truly blessed if we can be a blessing to others. To remember the poor, those less fortunate and lend a hand when needed can be something you'll never forget... nor will they.

Thank you to all those that have collections at your churches and to all that bring in food products to the Site Pantry. Stamp Out Hunger was a tremendous success through the Ida Grove Postal Service in May.

Proverbs 22:9 - "The generous will themselves be blessed, for they share their food with the poor."

Our Community Basket provided **100 families** with nutritious food in May at the Odebolt Community Center. Thank you to Marne and Jim Barker for lining up the mobile. Vicar Travis led the families and volunteers in prayer. We had 29 volunteers. Faith Lutheran Foundation donated 140 one-pound packages of hamburger, Barb Daiker wrote a Thrivent Grant providing toilet paper for each family, Jim/Marne Barker donated heavy duty plastic canvas bags, the Odebolt Presbyterian Church donated loaves of bread, hot dog buns and hamburger buns., and Jeff and Kim Fineran of Wall Lake donated 60 many bread loaves. These extra donations added to our baskets that our families received. We work with the Food Bank of Iowa when our mobile is held in Sac County.

Arthur-(11), Battle Creek-(12), Galva-(6), Holstein-(16), Ida Grove-(31), Kiron-(4), Odebolt-(16), Other Communities-(4) 267 individuals served=88 adults and 79 children

Our Site Pantry had **54 families** coming for baskets totaling 170 individuals=106 adults and 64 children. We were opened for three Thursdays. Arthur (4), Battle Creek (5), Galva (1), Holstein (2), Ida Grove (35), Kiron (3), and Odebolt (3) other communities (1).

Our next mobile will be on June 18th at the Fire Station in Holstein with Bonnie Barkema steer heading this mobile. The truck comes in at 12:45 and we finish around 6:30. Then several volunteers bring the food not distributed back to the Site Pantry in Ida Grove to place it on our shelves or in our freezers. Many volunteer hours are given to keep this outreach ministry working. Reach out to her to help serve. Any amount of time you can give is most appreciated.
